Upon approval of the application by the school, it will be presented to the Foundation for final consideration. Those wishing to perpetually fund these type of ministry opportunities can make tax deductible contributions to the Foundation. Please contact the Foundation for further information.

Your tax deductible donation will be contributed to a principal sum that will never be consumed under the provision of the Foundation. The vision granted by God to Mr. Elliott to support ministry and childcare can be part of your calling as well.

In following our Lord's direction each year, the Foundation first makes its 10% tithe to the Harrodsburg Baptist Church. Then in keeping with its founding purpose, the remaining 90% is divided equally between Christian Vocational Scholarships and Kentucky Baptist Childcare.

Every dollar contributed will perpetually provides resources for the Foundation to award monies to see that the education of those seeking a full time career in ministry and that Baptist Childcare have additional monies to operate.

Gifts to the Foundation have included monetary amounts, as well as stock certificates and real estate. The Foundation is often the beneficiary of wills, estates or honorariums. Funds are then invested and managed by state and local financial institutions.

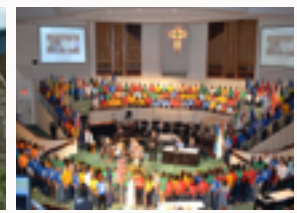
